THEME OF THE CONVENTION

The experts from the Dairy and Food Industry will also deliberate on the problems of the application of Instrumentation & automation. The latest developments in software as applicable to dairy and food industry will also be addressed by experts in the field.

This convention and national seminar will focus on the following sub themes:

1. Application of Biosensors in Dairy and Food Industry
2. Automation in liquid milk processing with advanced hygienic design
3. Advances in automation of Traditional Indian Dairy products production
4. Advances in automation of evaporators and dryers
5. Development of safety systems automation in dairy plant operation
6. Role of instruments in preventing dairy equipment failure and optimum operation

TECHNICAL PROGRAM

Following activities will be programmed during the annual convention and national seminar.

ORAL PRESENTATION

Each oral presentation is given a total time of 20 minutes (15 min. of presentation & 5 min. of discussion). The LCD's will be provided. A presentation in the form of Microsoft Power Point for windows is recommended.

POSTER PRESENTATION

Contributions in the form of poster presentation on the thematic area of the convention are invited. A space of 90 X 90 cm will be provided for poster presentation. Upon evaluation by a panel of eminent scientists, best poster awards (2 Nos.) will be given.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS AND EXTENDED SUMMARY

The extended summaries will be published in the souvenir along with the invited papers from eminent dairy engineers. Abstracts not exceeding 300 words & extended summaries not exceeding 1500 words (inclusive of abstract) may be sent in duplicate to the Organizing Secretary by post along with a soft copy on CD (12 point, Times New Roman) or by E-mail idea2012tirupati@gmail.com. The content of the abstract should include: background, objectives, methods, results and conclusions without these headlines. The title should be in capitals and in bold. The extended summary shall have following subheadings: Introduction, Materials & Methods, Results & Discussions and Conclusions. Abstract with registration fee only be considered for publication. The official language of the convention is English.

ABOUT TIRUPATI

Tirupati is a small but beautiful and holy city located at foot hills of famous tirumala hills. The weather conditions in September are pleasant and temperature ranges from 30-35°C

HOW TO REACH TIRUPATI

The distance from Tirupati Airport, Renigunta is around 15 km. It is well connected through rail and bus services. If informed in advance arrangements will be made to pick up the delegates from tirupati railway station and Bus Stand.

LOCAL TOUR

The place of conference is a well known pilgrim center. Depending on the choice of delegates, a post seminar tour to Lord Venkateswara (Lord Balaji) temple on tirumala hills, about 23 km from tirupati can be arranged. The other important pilgrim centers are Vayulingeswara Swamy (Srikalahasthi, 37 km), Varasiddi vinayaka temple (Kanipakam, 67 km), Tirttani (60 km), Srinivasa mangapuram (12 km), Alivelu mangapuram (7 km), Chandragiri Fort, an important historical place is also nearby.
